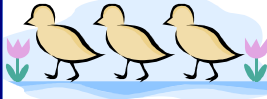

How to Submit an Online Service Request

Go to <https://www.accway.com>. This website will take you to the “Welcome to the American Campus Communities Resident Portal.”

1. If you have not already created an account, click “DON’T HAVE AN ACCOUNT YET” under Log In.
2. Enter the personal information requested. Be sure to enter the email address stated on your application, your last name, date of birth and the last four digits of your social security number.
3. Upon completion of creating your new account, check your email! Receive conformation of your new pass word.
4. Log back on to <https://www.accway.com> and access the portal using your new pass word.
5. Your general lease information will appear on your home page. Go to the Service Request tab.
6. Enter the information regarding your service request and click “SUBMIT SERVICE REQUEST” at the bottom of the page.

Your service request has been submitted!
Enter as much detail as possible when submitting a service request on line. If you have any questions refer to the “Resident Portal FAQ” sheet or call the Service Desk at 757-402-4245/4253.

NOTE

The Resident Portal is NOT for emergency work orders. You must submit emergency works orders by calling the Service Desk at (757) 402-4245 / 4253

This month's DC topic is "abandoned vehicles in HHR parking lots."

Believe it or not, back in the day, I made the same 6 to 8 months deployments you make today. Deployments required advanced planning, especially when it came to storing and protecting my prized possession....my car! Name of the game... protect my investment during those extended underways. The options available at the time were the NEX long term stowage facility or the occasional backyard of a friend. Either way, time was taken to properly secure my vehicle. It was not left in some obscure parking lot with the hope it would be there upon my return.

With that being said, HHR contracts Jack's Towing Service to remove abandoned or decrepit vehicles from the properties. What does Jack's use to make the determination? Easy...they look for expired registration tags, expired safety inspection and missing HHR parking decal.

Yes, a parking decal. Residents with vehicles are issued a "parking decal" at check-in. This decal serves as a parking permit and it assists in the identification of residents.

Bottom Line...Parking is for current residents only. Abandoned or decrepit vehicles will be towed at owner's expense. So if you are deploying in the near future, be sure to make arrangements for vehicle stowage. Save Yourself Some Money and Heartache!

Shipmates,

We have had a very busy start to 2011 and there are several important issues affecting us this year that you need to be aware of and stay informed about, such as the implementation of the repeal of Don't Ask, Don't Tell, the effects of the Continuing Resolution on PCS orders, Fleet RIDE/PTS, "Spice" and other designer drugs, Sexual Assault and Suicide prevention.

Implementation of the repeal of Don't Ask, Don't Tell:

By now, you should have seen the latest NAVADMINs on the implementation of the repeal of Don't Ask, Don't Tell. If you have not, take the time to review them and understand the upcoming expectations.

NAVADMINS 041/11 provides Sailors with additional information and guidance for implementation and NAVADMIN 042/11 outlines requirements for Navy training prior to repeal certification and provides specific direction for training completion and documentation.

Treating each other with dignity and respect has long been the hallmark of naval service and culture, and the foundation for the standards of behavior and conduct toward each other. Those values will guide the Navy through this process and ensure its success. Official information on the repeal of DADT can be found at <http://www.dadtrepeal.navy.mil/>.

BLUF: Navy currently doesn't have sufficient manpower funding to allow for normal lead times for Sailors to receive PCS orders. Navy's goal is to minimize the impact to Sailors and families.

NAVADMIN 049/11 informed the Fleet of the impact to permanent change of station (PCS) orders while operating under a continuing resolution (CR), which is a Congressional budget authorization that allows for continuous normal operations while a final budget is approved. Sailors detaching in the next few months who have not yet received orders will likely have less than two months lead time when the orders are released.

Emphasis will remain on global support assignment rotations, career milestone billets, critical readiness fills, minimizing gaps at sea for deployed units and those working up to deploy, and keeping the training pipelines moving.

BLUF: Are you or your shipmates eligible for up to \$18,000 for a 2 year extension at-sea?

Sea Duty Incentive Pay (SDIP) was authorized as a pilot program in March 2007 by NAVADMIN 070/07. The SDIP program is designed as an incentive for Sailors in certain ratings, pay grades or with specific NEC's to voluntarily remain on sea duty past their prescribed sea tour or curtail their current shore duty tour and return early to sea duty.

SDIP **cannot** be requested or approved once the Sailor has detached their current permanent duty station, so act soon. Up-to-date policies, procedures, guidelines and SDIP Eligibility Chart are provided on the NPC website.

She is further tested by a troubled marriage, a scandal and World War I. Annabelle rises above it all choosing a life of service to others and triumphs in the end. A 10-hour blockbuster.

For those who like their stories a little more menacing, there's "Hannibal Rising" by Thomas Harris (who is also the reader on this audio). The story before "Silence of the Lambs" explains what demons possessed Hannibal Lector from his earliest days. Being Discharged Soon?

If you are; there are some things you should know. First, you need to complete a Notice to Vacate with our Leasing Department and second, you need see the bookkeepers regarding your final rent payment. The primary reason behind this...PSD will stop your allotments 30 days prior to your discharge date and due to this fact, you will receive your BAH in your check. Remember, your BAH covers your PPV rent and normally comes to us via allotment. Since the BAH will be in your checking account you need to pay your PPV rent directly! If you vacate without properly settling your account and if we don't hear from you within 45 days, your account will be turned over to Norfolk General District Court for collections. As a note; you are entitled to and will receive your BAH until the last day on active duty. **It is your responsibility to ensure your rent is paid prior to being discharged.** HHR bookkeepers are available to answer any of your questions. They can be contacted Monday – Friday, 0730 – 1600 at 757-402-4230/33/34.

Move-out Policy

When moving out of PPV Housing you are required to give HHR a 30 day written Notice of Intent to Vacate in person. They will then schedule pre-inspection and set the date for final inspection. You will be responsible for any damages or cleaning needing to be done. Upon check out you will turn in your access card, room key and parking permit. 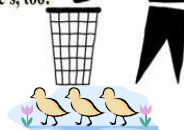
